## Fractured Fairytales and ReMixed Myths

A WHOLISTIC PERFORMING ARTS CLASS

<u>COURSE DESCRIPTION</u>: In this theatre class, students will use well-known folklore, myths and fairytales to create an original adventure story that reflects their own experiences. Along the way, they will explore creative storytelling techniques, character analysis, voice and movement skills for the stage. Students will develop their performance through improv games and ensemble-building exercises. They will also explore singing technique and beginning music theory. In the end, their newly devised work will feature scenes and a fun musical opening and closing number that will introduce them to the fundamentals of musical theater in preparation for the spring musical.

INSTRUCTOR: Khalia Davis is a multidisciplinary artist and former artistic director of Bay Area Children's Theatre specializing in the creation of new work for family audiences. As a director and arts educator, she has worked on Broadway, off-Broadway and regionally with prominent theaters all over the country most recently as the assistant director for *The Hippest Trip: The Soul Train Musical* at the American Conservatory Theater. Ms. Davis believes that every young person deserves to experience the arts and has devoted her career to making that possible in all the communities she serves.
